

## RIVERWOOD RECIPES

Wild Rice Soup
Mari Lou McCormic
Mortgage Lender • Monticello

Ingredients:

Makes about 6 cups

- 6 Tbsp butter
- 1 Tbsp minced onion
- 1/2 cup flour
- 4 cups chicken broth
- 2 cups cooked wild rice \*

Buttermilk Cinnamon Bars Patsy Klang Teller • Big Lake

#### Ingredients:

- 1 1/4 cup white sugar
- 3/4 cup brown sugar
- 2 cups flour
- 2/3 cup butter or margarine
- 1/2 cup coconut
- 1/2 cup chopped walnuts

1/3 cup minced ham

1/2 cup finely grated carrots

3 Tbsp slivered almonds

1/2 tsp salt

1 cup half-n-half cream

2 Tbsp dry sherry (or white wine)

Snipped parsley or chives (garnish)

\* Boil 1 cup uncooked wild rice (yields 2 cups cooked) in 3 cups of water and simmer down until water is absorbed. Set aside.

Melt butter in saucepan and sauté onion until tender. Blend in flour and gradually stir in broth. Cook, stirring constantly until boiling. Boil for one minute. Stir in rice, ham, carrots, almonds and salt. Simmer about 5 minutes.

Blend in cream and sherry. Heat to serving temperature. Garnish with parsley or chives.

1 egg

1/2 tsp salt

1 tsp cinnamon

1 tsp baking powder

1 tsp vanilla

1 Cup buttermilk

Icing:

1/2 cup powdered sugar

1 tablespoon butter

1 tablespoon milk

Combine white sugar, brown sugar, flour and butter as you would for pastry using a pastry blender.

Combine 2 cups of this mixture with coconut and walnuts.

Press into the bottom of a greased 9x13 pan; set aside.

With remaining mixture, add egg, salt, cinnamon, baking powder, vanilla and buttermilk.

Spread over crust.

Bake at 350 degrees for 35 minutes.

While still warm frost with thin icing.
